You can use the vocabulary in singular and plural forms.

Singular: "a" = "one"

Examples:

a book = one book a pen = one pen

Plural: add "s"

Examples:

books = more than one book pencils = more than one pencil

In the classroom

To ask the location of an item in the classroom, we use the form: "Where is the ...?"

Example:

Where is the pen?

Where is the whiteboard? Where is the calendar?

To ask if something is in the classroom, use the form: "Is there a...in the classroom?" or "Are there... the classroom?" (review the answers to the questions)

Examples:

Is there a pencil in the classroom? Yes, there is./No, there isn't. Is there a desk in the classroom? Yes, there is./No, there isn't. Is there a computer in the classroom? Yes, there is./No, there isn't.

Are there books in the classroom? Yes, there are./No, there aren't. Yes, there are./No, there aren't. Are there notebooks in the classroom? Yes, there are./No, there aren't.

To ask someone for an item in the classroom, use the form: "Do you have...? (review the answers to the questions)

Examples:

Do you have a book? Yes, I do./No, I don't.
Do you have a notebook? Yes, I do./No, I don't.
Do you have pencils? Yes, I do./No, I don't.
Do you have notebooks? Yes, I do./No, I don't.




