There are different types of weather during the year.

These different types of weather are categorized into *seasons*. We have four seasons and each season has different types of weather.

<p>FALL/AUTUMN In fall, it's <i>cool</i>. In fall, it's <i>windy</i>. In fall, the <i>leaves</i> change color.</p>			<p>WINTER In winter, it's <i>cloudy</i>. In winter, it's <i>cold</i>. In winter, it's <i>snowy</i>.</p>
<p>SUMMER In summer, it's <i>hot</i>. In summer, it's <i>rainy</i>. In summer, it's <i>sunny</i>.</p>			<p>SPRING In spring, it's <i>warm</i>. In spring, the <i>flowers</i> bloom. In spring, it's <i>windy</i>.</p>

In all places, seasons are different. Look at the table below to see when seasons most often happen.

"Fall" is commonly used in the United States. In other countries, the months before winter and after summer are called "Autumn."

For example:

In summer, it's hot.

In winter, it's cold.

In spring, it's sunny.

- To ask about the weather, use the question: *How is the weather?*
